Academic Medals

Purpose: Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals are an academic award designed to recognise students who excel in thier study areas.
Timing: The Academic Medals are presented to students who meet the criteria outlined below each semester.
Data: The data used to determine eligibility will be drawn exclusively from Semester Student Reports.

## Criteria P-6

Gold: Very High Achievement (A) in 80\% of the core subjects. Two must be English and Maths. No less than a High Achievement ( $B$ ) in the other subjects.
Silver: Very High Achievement (A) in 60\% of core subjects. One must be English or Maths. No less than a High Achievement (B) in the other subjects.

Bronze: Very High Achievement (A) in $40 \%$ of core subjects. One must be English or Maths. No less than a C in the other subjects.

## Criteria 7-12

Gold: Very High Achievement (A) in $85 \%$ of the number of subjects they study. No less than a High Achievement (B) in the other subjects.
Silver: Very High Achievement (A) in 70\% of the number of subjects they study. No less than a High Achievement (B) in the other subjects.
Bronze: Very High Achievement (A) in 60\% of the number of subjects they study. No less than a High Achievement (B) in the other subjects.
