The Rides



This year, the Moonlight Fair will have Dodgems, a Giant Slide, Laser Skirmish, a Jumping Castle, an Obstacle Course and a Giant Chairs Ride.



Tickets and Armbands can be purchased from the ticket stand near the stage (Single Rides \$5, Armbands \$25).

Ride Armbands

Armbands are \$25 each and allow unlimited, continuous entry to rides. Armbands can be purchased on the night or right now on FLEXISCHOOLS. Any pre-purchased armbands can be collected from 5-5:30pm on the night of the Moonlight Fair. Armband collection will be near the McDowall St entrance. After 5:30pm, pickup is from the ticket stand near the stage.

Terms and Conditions for Armband Purchases

1. ARMBANDS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN RIDING. ANY ARMBAND THAT HAS BEEN TAMPERED WITH WILL NOT BE HONOURED AT THE RIDES AND WILL BE SENT BACK TO THE TICKET OFFICE.
2. Before purchasing an armband please check that your child will be able to ride. There are height and size restrictions. Riders with medical injuries will not be allowed on eg. broken or sprained limbs, not able to hold themselves up right and any injury we deem unsafe to ride with.
3. Small children will not be allowed on major rides even with an adult. Dodgems are the exception. Please check the height list for full details. An **Adult** does not require an armband to accompany a small child.
4. Ride Operators are in charge of the rides, not the queues. Queue jumpers, or riders who behave in an unsafe manner or who vandalize the rides may have their armbands suspended.
5. Any rider who looks sick or has had too many turns on a particular ride will be asked to take a break.
6. Some rides cannot be operated in adverse weather conditions such as high winds, rain and storms.
7. Larger riders may not be able to be seated correctly. Seat restraints must fit the riders without squashing them.



Ride restrictions

RIDE	HEIGHT TO RIDE	CONDITIONS
DODGEMS	Minimum 900mm to ride and must take an adult to drive. 1300mm to drive alone	No medical injuries. A child must be 1300mm to drive without an adult. Small riders sit on the left. All children to wear a seatbelt and be able to support themselves in a sitting position. Footwear must be worn.
GIANT SLIDE	Minimum 950mm to ride alone	No medical injuries. Only an adult can double a small child. Small children are to sit between adult's legs on the mat and must be able to support themselves in a sitting position. Footwear must be worn.
LASER SKIRMISH	4 years and over	No medical injuries. Must be able to hold the gun. Footwear must be worn. No flips. No running into walls.
CASTLE & OBSTACLE COURSE	2 years and over	No medical injuries. No shoes. No flips. No running into walls. No rough play.
GIANT CHAIRS RIDE	Minimum 1m to ride alone	No medical injuries. Must be able to support themselves in a sitting position.
