PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

18th August 2021

Religious Life of the School

Last Wednesday 28th July, St Johns staff from our K-12 campus came together for our annual Bishop's Inservice Day. Whilst it was a day off for students, all staff worked individually and collectively on their faith and formation. The theme this year aligned with "Living the Spirit. The day was led by Toowoomba Catholic Education staff member Angela Travers and our Assistant Principal Faith and Mission, Trish Parker. We were also joined by special guest presenter, Dr Mark Copland, Mission Executive St Vincent's Private Hospital Toowoomba. Mark assisted Angela in delivering learning to staff on "pedagogy of encounter". The essence of this work was to teach staff how deliver learning experiences in Religious Education that engage students in dialogue concerning relevant present- day issues. Such days allow staff to reflect on our shared faith which in turns drives and reaffirms the school's values, ethos, and charism. This is core to maintaining the "Spirit" of St Johns School which is valued so highly within our community. I extend my sincere thanks to Angela, Mark, and Trish for leading such an engaging and enriching day.

COVID-19

The COVID-19 situation in Queensland continues to be a rapidly developing situation. Currently St John's School continues to operate as usual as the Maranoa Region is outside of the 11 Local Government Areas in lockdown. Queensland Health advice. St John's School will continue to monitor the developing situation and Government advice. This may have implications for upcoming school events such as school camps and excursions. One such event is the Year 6 camp to Brisbane. Toowoomba Catholic Education Office has advised that for the remainder of term 3 any excursion or camp outside of the Toowoomba Diocese should be either postponed or cancelled. Unfortunately, the Year 6 camp to Brisbane set down for week 10 of this term has been cancelled. Families should continue to monitor the St John's Facebook page and school app for changes to school events and routines.

Excursions

Year 9 students travel to the Bunya Mountains next Monday 9th August on a two- day camp as part of their Outdoors Education Program. They will be implementing camping and hiking skills developed over the course of the year. Thank you to Sam and Ashleigh Valentine who will be leading this excursion.

Next week we farewell our Year 5 students who will travel to Charleville on Thursday for a two- day camp. They will engage in several learning experiences including the Cosmos and Royal Flying Doctor's Centre. Thank you to the Year 5 teachers, Karen Ey and Matt Wilke who have planned and will lead the camp. They will also be accompanied by Deputy Principal Ryan Doig and Miss Meg Lyons.

Extra- Curricular Events

Last week students from across the campus engaged in a range of extra- curricular events. Many students experienced dance workshops with the Queensland Ballet whilst over 130 students represented St John's School at the Roma and District Athletics Carnival. Thank you to Miss Emily Stoops and Meg Lyons who facilitated the respective events. On Tuesday Mr Penrose and Mrs Lunney ventured to Roma State College with Mathematicians from Year 5,6,7 and 8 to participate in the QAMT Mathematics Challenge. St John's students participated exceptionally well and enjoyed the challenging experiences. Last Thursday 29th July 16 girls in Years 4, 5, and 6 participated in the Catholic Schools Netball competition in Toowoomba. The students played 6 games of netball against other Toowoomba schools. The girls' behaviour on and off the court was exemplary. The two competing teams had wins on the day and most of all they enjoyed the experience. It was wonderful to have St John's represented as part of the Toowoomba diocese. A special thanks to Angela Pollock for her preparation and coaching of the students involved.

Staffing

Hayley Ownsworth has commenced in Year 4 and replaces Michaela Wehl. She has made a seamless transition with students and staff and has been well supported by staff.

The school is advertising for the Assistant Principal Curriculum position (which Denise will retire from at the end of 2021). Applications close 29 August, followed by shortlisting and interviewing week 10.

Majella Galway is taking LSL commencing this week for personal reasons. The leave will be for the remainder of the term. Her classes will be taken over by Jen Free and Nicole Southee.

The school has been able to transition 14 staff from fixed term contracts to ongoing/permanent positions. This recognises service, proficiency and seeks to increase staff stability.

Emilly Stopps (Drama, Legal Studies, Dance) has advised she will not be returning in 2021. The school is currently engaged in a recruitment process with interviews next week.

Andrei Dobrota (Mathematics, Xaverian Pastoral Leader) has been successful to securing a leadership position in Cairns. He is replaced by Chloe Tiley.

Dana Jacquin (Prep) will return to Brisbane in 2021. We have secured Ellen Kehl as a replacement teacher for P-6 in 2022.

- Race Day wrap up – Costings are still not known but approx. \$19K was raised for the day.
- Fathers day breakfast – September 2nd. A flyer is needed to be done. Anita to contact Megan Hooper to organise an RSVP event. Food to be served from 7am. Anita to organise food. Leesa to organise a table with info for Moonlight Fair. Bacon, Eggs, Pancakes & Fruit.
- Tuckshop Extension – An idea was brought to life with extending the front of the tuckshop. Belinda to look in to costings etc.
- Tuckshop equipment has arrived.
- Senior Area – We have \$100K given to school for senior area. Quote have come back Hutchison Builders with quote \$87,054 excl. GST. Fix drainage, Astro turf, redo pathways. Hutchison have started work on this area. Jim proposed that the money remaining goes towards enhancing the seating in that area.
- Instrumental Program – Michael Kale, music teacher – Audit of instruments was done. \$30-\$40K approx. for replacement instruments. P&F to talk about it over the next few minutes. Seeking support for the instrumental music program from the P&F by committing \$12K per year for the next 4 years for phased replacement of all instruments.
- Naming of Senior building – Options - John the Baptist Learning Centre, Sr Attracta McGillicuddy building, St Therese Lisieux Centre. The P&F gave Jim their choice of McGillicuddy Centre. The bishop to decide.
- Uniforms – Uniform Locker contacted the school around the shorts and pants for girls - August – November arrival.
