



# Academic Medals



**Purpose:** Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals are an academic award designed to recognise students who excel in their study areas.

**Timing:** The Academic Medals are presented to students who meet the criteria outlined below each semester.

**Data:** The data used to determine eligibility will be drawn exclusively from Semester Student Reports.

## Criteria P-6

**Gold:** Very High Achievement (A) in 80% of the core subjects. Two must be English and Maths. No less than a High Achievement (B) in the other subjects.

**Silver:** Very High Achievement (A) in 60% of core subjects. One must be English or Maths. No less than a High Achievement (B) in the other subjects.

**Bronze:** Very High Achievement (A) in 40% of core subjects. One must be English or Maths. No less than a C in the other subjects.

## Criteria 7-12

**Gold:** Very High Achievement (A) in 85% of the number of subjects they study. No less than a High Achievement (B) in the other subjects.

**Silver:** Very High Achievement (A) in 70% of the number of subjects they study. No less than a High Achievement (B) in the other subjects.

**Bronze:** Very High Achievement (A) in 60% of the number of subjects they study. No less than a High Achievement (B) in the other subjects.
